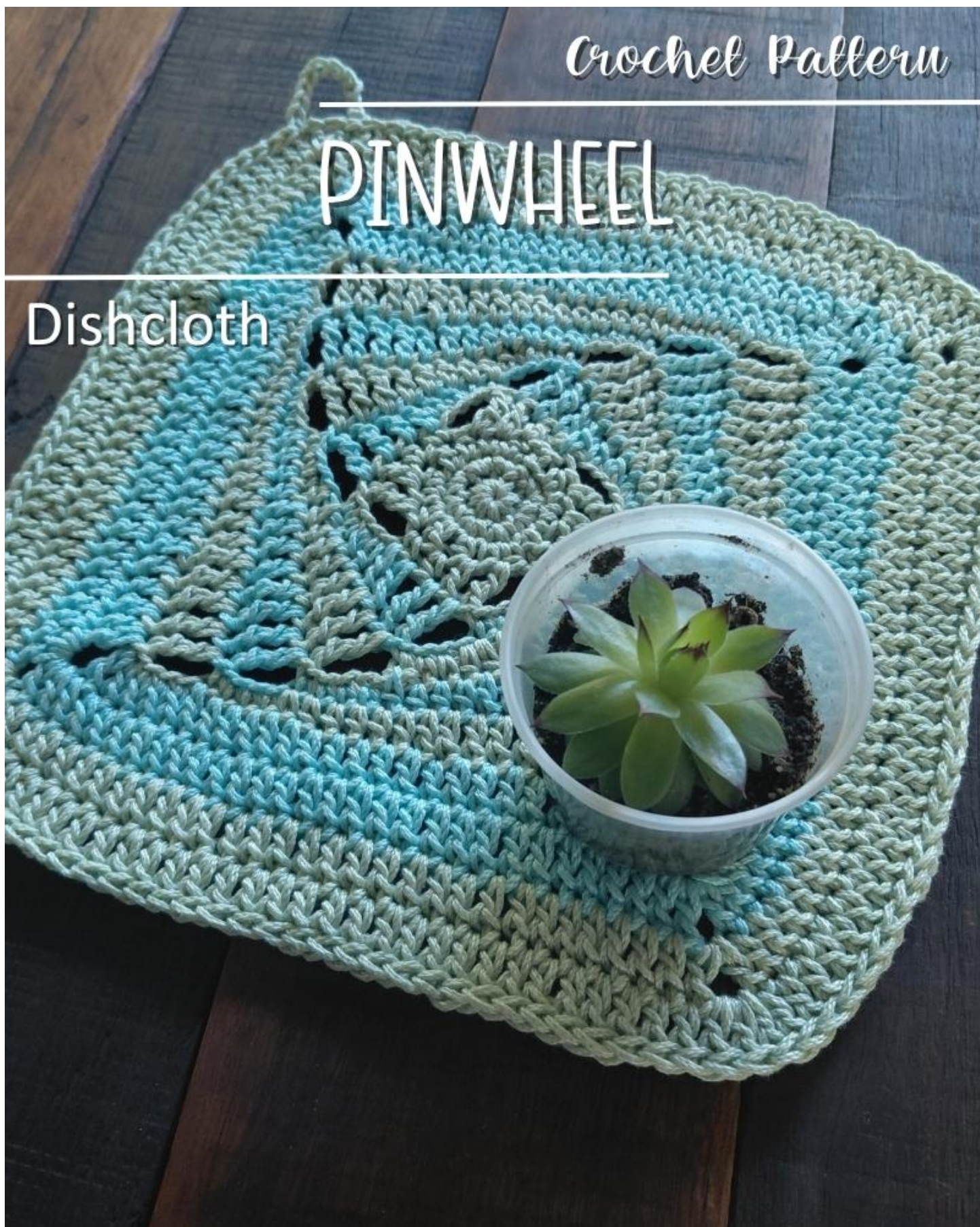


Crochet Pattern

PINWHEEL

Dishcloth



Pinwheel Crochet Dishcloth- designed by Joanita Theron

This beautiful two-toned dishcloth features a delicate pinwheel design that's both decorative and practical. It's a quick and enjoyable project that's perfect for using around the home or gifting to someone special.

Difficulty Level | Skills Required



- Easy – concentration required.

Basic stitches in simple variations, simple repeats, color changes, shaping and finishing.

You will need to know basic stitches like SC (single crochet) and DC (double crochet).

Special stitches explained and provided in the instructions.

Materials

- ✓ Hook – 4, 00 mm (G)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Yarn needle

Yarn:

Lion Brand 24/7 Cotton - worsted-weight (9 wpi), mercerized 100% natural fiber yarn.

A – Mint

B – Aqua

Yarn Substitute:

Using the same type of yarn throughout the project is recommended. The pattern suggests worsted weight (9 wpi) 4: medium), but you are not limited to this type of yarn. Any yarn can be used if you take into consideration your sizing for the project will differ.

Tension | Gauge

Gauge is NOT necessary for this project to be perfect.

However COUNTING your stitches will ensure true success of this project!

Size

Approx. Length and width = 9 ½ inches / 24 cm

Remember – if you use/choose a different yarn weight/hook size your dishcloth will be a different size!

Abbreviations: US Terminology

CH – chain

SL ST – slip stitch

SC – single crochet (UK – DC)

HDC – half double crochet (UK – HTR)

DC – double crochet (UK – TR)

TR – treble crochet (UK – DTR)

BLP – back loop

RS – Right side

WS – Wrong side

Special Stitches

How to Make a Magic Circle/Ring (double):

- **Wrap the yarn around the fingers of your left hand twice** - to create two loops. The tail should be in the back on the right side, while the working yarn should be in the front towards your palm.
- **Pull up a loop.** Slide your crochet hook under the two loops of your double ring closest to your fingertips. Grab onto the working end of the yarn and pull it back through to the right, creating a loop on the hook.
- **Make a starting chain.** Grab onto the working end of the yarn and draw it through the loop currently on your hook, creating a single chain stitch.
- Pull the ring from your index finger.
- **Crochet as many stitches as needed** - according to your pattern's instructions.
- **Pull on the tail yarn lightly** – THEN pull on the THE loop that moved until hole is closed; THEN pull-on tail yarn again to completely close the hole.



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INSTRUCTIONS:

With A – make a magic ring/or CH 4; SL ST into 4th CH from hook to form a ring.

RND 1: Work 8 SC into ring. (**8 SC**)

RND 2: Work 2 SC into each SC all around; SL ST into first SC worked. (**16 SC**)

RND 3: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC); work 1 HDC into next SC; work 1 SC into next SC; work 1 HDC into next SC.

*Work 1 DC into next SC; work 1 HDC into next SC; work 1 SC into next SC; work 1 HDC into next SC.** Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into 3rd of 3 CH.

(**16 STS**)

RND 4: Work 1 SC into same CH; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; **CH 4.**

*Work 1 SC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; **CH 4.** ** Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into first SC worked.

(**16 STS; 4 x CH 4 spaces**) **Fasten off and weave in ends.**

Note: For the following rounds work into the CH stitches NOT the CH space for each 4 CH corner space.

With B – join into FIRST CH of a 4 CH space with a **SC**.

RND 5: Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 TR into ST; work 1 TR into ST; **CH 4.**

*Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 TR into ST; work 1 TR into ST; **CH 4.** **

Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into first SC worked.

(**8 STS on each side; 4 x CH 4 spaces**) **Fasten off and weave in ends.**

Quick Version:

*Into 4 CH STS – SC; SC; HDC; HDC;

continue - DC; DC; TR; TR; CH 4. **

Repeat from * to ** 3 more times.

With A – join into FIRST CH of a 4 CH space with a **SC**.

RND 6: Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST;

work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST;

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work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST;
work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; **CH 4.**

* Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST;
work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST;
work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST;

Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into first SC worked.

(12 STS on each side; 4 x CH 4 spaces) Fasten off and weave in ends.

Quick Version:

*Into 4 CH STS – SC; SC; SC; HDC;
continue – HDC; HDC; DC; DC; DC; TR; TR; TR; **CH 4. ****
Repeat from * to ** 3 more times.

With B – join into FIRST CH of a 4 CH space with a **SC**.

RND 7: Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST;
work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC
into next ST;
work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST;
work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST;
CH 4.

* Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC

Quick Version:

continue – HDC; HDC; HDC; HDC; DC; DC; DC; DC; TR; TR; TR; TR; **CH 4. ****
Repeat from * to ** 3 more times.

With A – join into FIRST CH of a 4 CH space with a **SC**.

RND 8: Work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST; work 1 SC into next CH ST;
work 1 HDC into next CH ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST; work 1 HDC into next ST;
work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST; work 1 DC into next ST;
work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; work 1 TR into next ST; **CH 4**.

(20 STS on each side; 4 x CH 4 spaces) Fasten off and weave in ends.

Quick Version:

*Into 4 CH STS – SC; SC; SC; SC;
continue – SC; HDC; HDC; HDC; HDC; HDC; DC; DC; DC; DC; DC; TR; TR; TR; TR; TR; **CH 4**. **
Repeat from * to ** 3 more times.

With A – join into FIRST CH of a 4 CH space.

RND 9: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC); work 1 DC into SAME CH ST;
work 1 DC into each of next 3 CH ST; work 1 DC into each of next 19 STS;
work 2 DC into last ST; **CH 3**.

*Work 2 DC into next CH ST; work 1 DC into each of next 3 CH ST; work 1 DC into each of next 19 STS; work 2 DC into last ST; **CH 3**. **

Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into 3rd of 3 CH.

(26 DC on each side; 4 x 3 CH corner spaces)

RND 10: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC); work 1 DC into each of next 25 DC; work [2 DC; 2 CH; 2 DC] into next 3 CH corner space.

*Work 1 DC into each of next 26 DC; work [2 DC; 2 CH; 2 DC] into next 3 CH corner space. **
Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into 3rd of 3 CH.

(30 DC on each side; 4 x 2 CH corner spaces) Fasten off and weave in ends.

With A – join into any 2 CH corner space.

RND 11: CH 5 (counts as 1 DC; 2 CH space); work 1 DC into SAME corner space;
work 1 DC into each of next 30 DC.

*Work [1 DC; 2 CH; 1 DC] into next 2 CH corner space; work 1 DC into each of next 30 DC. **
Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into 3rd of 5 CH.

(32 DC on each side; 4 x 2 CH corner spaces)

RND 12: SL ST into next corner space; CH 3 (counts as 1 DC); work 2 DC into SAME corner space; work 1 DC into each of next 32 DC.

*Work 3 DC into next corner space; work 1 DC into each of next 32 DC. **
Repeat from * to ** 2 more times; SL ST into 3rd of 3 CH

Optional:

RND 13: CH 10 (or length required); SL ST into each DC all around; ending with a SL ST into first SL ST worked.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
